PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

In the Matter of Valerie Lancaster Beal
a member of **City University of New York Board of Trustees**

1. Respondent was required to file the annual statement of financial disclosure ("Statement") for calendar year 2007 by May 15, 2008, as required by Public Officers Law §73-a, because Respondent was designated as a policy-maker serving as a member.
2. Respondent was sent a Notice of Failure to File on July 1, 2008 and subsequently, on January 29, 2009, she was sent a Notice of Delinquency.
3. Respondent was sent a Notice of Hearing on July 29, 2009.
4. The hearing was concluded on August 26, 2009 at 11:30a.m. in Albany, New York. Respondent failed to appear.
