Failure to Timely File a 2009 January/June
Client Semi-Annual Report

A Notice of Hearing was issued on December 15, 2011 and duly served on Respondent, Housing Works, Inc. ("Respondent"). A hearing was held on January 19, 2011. The Hearing Officer issued written Findings of Fact and a Recommendation on January 20, 2011, which were duly served on Respondent. Respondent was provided a ten-day period within which to respond in writing to the Hearing Officer's Findings of Fact and Recommendation. Respondent did not submit any such response.

At its February 15, 2011 meeting, the New York State Commission on Public Integrity ("Commission") considered the hearing officer's Findings of Fact and Recommendation in the above-captioned matter.

The Commission affirms the hearing officer's finding that Respondent knowingly and wilfully failed to timely file the 2009 January/June Client Semi-Annual Report and directs that Respondent be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2000 if it properly completes the Report and returns it to the Commission within thirty (30) days of receipt of service of the Decision; or

Respondent be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000 if it properly completes the Report and returns it to the Commission on or after (31) days of receipt of service of the Decision
