NOTICE OF DELINQUENCY

The New York State Joint Commission on Public Ethics (the "Commission") has received information indicating that you are a candidate for public office. As such, pursuant to Section 73-a(2)(a) of the Public Officers Law ("POL"), you were required to file an Annual Statement of Financial Disclosure ("Statement") within ten days of commencing your candidacy. This statutory requirement is separate and distinct from campaign disclosure requirements that may or may not have been required under State Election Law.

Commission records indicate that you have failed to file the required Statement, in violation of the law. Pursuant to the authority granted by Executive Law Sections 94(11) and (12), the Commission sent you a confidential Notice of Failure to File on October 9, 2015, requesting you file the Statement for year 2014 on or before October 26, 2015. Commission records indicate that you still have not filed the Statement.

You must file the Statement with the Legislative Ethics Commission by November 17, 2015. If you fail to comply by November 17, 2015, you may, after additional notice and a hearing, be subject to a civil penalty of an amount up to \$40,000.
