

The Joint Commission on Public Ethics is developing guidelines and regulations relating to new disclosure requirements for lobbyists and clients of lobbyists pursuant to The Public Integrity Reform Act of 2011. As part of that process, the Commission is developing forms and instructions, both online and in hard copy, for lobbyists and clients to comply with the new source funding disclosure requirement pursuant to Legislative Law §§1-h (c) (4) and 1-j (c) (4). As these forms will necessarily track the regulations the Commission ultimately develops, they will not be available until those regulations are enacted. Lobbyists and clients potentially subject to the new disclosure requirements should continue to maintain their internal records to be able to meet the new requirements once the regulations are in place.
