Dear Mr. Stern:

I write to inform that you that the Joint Commission on Public Ethics (“Commission”) has approved NARAL Pro-Choice New York’s (“NARAL”) request for an exemption, pursuant to 19 NCYRR Part 938.4(b), from the source of funding disclosure requirements contained in the Public Integrity Reform Act of 2011. *See* Legislative Law Article 1-A §§1-h(c)(4), 1-j(c)(4); 19 NYCRR Part 938. The exemption is effective immediately and expires on July 16, 2016. For the avoidance of doubt, the exemption covers the client semi-annual reports required under Legislative Law Article 1-A §1-j up to and including the semi-annual report that is due on July 15, 2016. Should NARAL desire an exemption from the source of funding disclosure requirements for the semi-annual reports it is required to file after July 15, 2016, it must submit a new request to the Commission.
