I write concerning the application of NARAL Pro-Choice New York (“NARAL”) for an exemption from the source of funding disclosure requirements set forth in sections 1-h(c)(4) and 1-j(c)(4) of the Legislative Law. The Joint Commission on Public Ethics has determined that the exemption from disclosure will cover contributions made to NARAL through and including December 31, 2014. If NARAL wishes to seek a subsequent exemption from the source of funding disclosure requirements, it must do so no later than July 13, 2015, in accordance with 19 NYCRR 938.5(b).
